Information related to Course Registration

October 2021 Semester

Registration/Enrollment: 08 - 12 December 2021
Course Add/Drop, Late Registration: 13 – 24 December 2021

- Each course is a 3.00 credit hour course
- **M.Sc.** Students must earn a minimum of 36 credit hours, including 18 credit hour thesis. They should register 6-level courses to earn grades.
- **Postgraduate Diploma** Students must earn a minimum of 24 credit hours, including 6-credit hour thesis. They can register 5-level or 6-level courses to earn grades.
- PG. Diploma students can take 6000 level courses if there is no new 5000 level course
- Full-time students can register maximum 15 credits and minimum 12 credits.
- Part-time students can register maximum 9 credits and minimum 3 credits.
- M.Sc. students with engineering background must register WFM 6209: Interdisciplinary Field Research Methodology in Water Management
- WFM 6303: Integrated Water Resources Management is a mandatory course for M.Sc. students.
- Students can **switch** from full-time to part-time and vice-versa before a semester starts with prior approval.
- The **C grades**, up to maximum of **2 courses**, may be ignored for the calculation of GPA at the written request of the student to head/director, provided that the student has fulfilled the total course credit hour requirement in the remaining subjects with a minimum **GPA of 2.75**.
- Students may enroll for non-credit course(s) termed as audit course(s) where he/she will get **S or U grade**.

Course Add/Drop, Late Registration: 13 – 24 December 2021

- A student shall withdraw officially from a course within **2 working weeks** of the commencement of the semester or else grade in that course shall be recorded as F. A student may be permitted to add/drop courses within a specified period with the approval of his/her Advisor, Head/Director.
- For graduation a student must earn a **minimum GPA of 2.65** based on course work.
- **Maximum 2 courses** may be **repeated** (including F grades) for grade improvement with prior approval.
- A student shall not be allowed to continue if he/she gets **F grades in 3 or more courses** during his/her study period.
- If at the end of second or any subsequent semester the cumulative GPA falls **below 2.5** the student shall not be allowed to continue with the program.
