provided that the student has fulfilled the total course credit hour requirement in the remaining subjects with a minimum **GPA of 2.75**.

- Students may enroll for non-credit course(s) termed as audit course(s) where he/she will get **S** or **U** grade.
- A student shall withdraw officially from a course within **2 working weeks** of the commencement of the semester or else grade in that course shall be recorded as F. A student may be permitted to add/drop courses within a specified period with the approval of his/her Advisor, Head/Director.
- For graduation a student must earn a **minimum GPA of 2.65** based on course work.
- Maximum 2 courses (including F grades) may be repeated for grade improvement with prior approval.
- A student shall <u>not be allowed to continue</u> if he/she gets **F grades in 3 or more courses** during his/her study period.
- If at the end of the second or any subsequent semester the cumulative GPA falls **below 2.5** the student shall <u>not be allowed to continue</u> with the program.
